[1] In accordance with the reasons for judgment in this appeal issued on May 24, 2001, the learned trial judge has reassessed damages. We are advised that the appellant is now appealing that second assessment.

[2] The issue of costs of this appeal (decided May 24, 2001) is still outstanding. There is, apparently, a Calderbank letter.
